MUMBAI: Participating in the joint terminal operators' global "Go-Green" campaign, employees of APM Terminals Mumbai and the families of the local unit of the Indian Central Industrial Security Force (CISF) planted approximately 140 trees at the CISF barracks at Nhava Sheva in the Jawaharlal Nehru Port (JNP) complex, India's busiest Container Port.

It is the 29th-busiest container port in the world, with throughput of 4.47 million TEUs in 2014. APM Terminals Mumbai, a joint venture between APM Terminals and the Container Corporation of India Ltd. (CONCOR), is India's busiest container terminal, with a throughput of 1.99 million TEUs in 2014.
