Navi Mumbai, Nhava Sheva: With the capital dredging underway at Nhava Sheva's Jawaharlal Nehru Port (JNPT) ever larger container ships are making their way into the Port.

JN Port is a tidal port which had a draft of 12.5 meters. The ongoing dredging has deepened the draft to 13 meters. APM Terminals Mumbai is already catering to 9,000 TEU's vessels since the beginning of 2013. By the beginning of next year, the channel is expected to be dredged to 14 meters plus.

Dredging is extremely important to the Port to create deeper access or berths, translating an increase in volumes handled in the port and growth of India's EX-IM Trade.




Dedicated approach road for APM Terminals Mumbai (GTI)
